The National Bargaining Council for the Road Freight and Logistics Industry (NBCRFLI) would like to advise all employers, employees, and Industry stakeholders that all NBCRFLI offices nationwide will be closed on Tuesday, 30 June 2026.

This precautionary measure has been taken considering the planned national anti-immigration protest. The safety and well-being of our employees and stakeholders remain our highest priority.

Although our offices will be closed to the public, all NBCRFLI employees will be working remotely and will continue to provide services virtually.

Stakeholders with matters scheduled for Tuesday, 30 June 2026, are encouraged to proceed virtually where possible. Where this is not practical, we kindly request that you contact the relevant NBCRFLI office to arrange a postponement or discuss alternative arrangements.

All NBCRFLI offices will reopen and resume normal operations on Wednesday, 1 July 2026.

We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we take these precautionary steps to safeguard everyone.
